ACTIVATION

- Start by asking students what's the difference between online and offline bullying
- Handout 'Bullying Drawing Sheet' 1 per student
- Have students draw what in-person bullying and cyber bullying looks or feels like – encourage them to be as creative as they like
- Hang the worksheets around the room and give students time to walk around and look at each other's work

REFLECTION / EXTENSION

- Ask the students to share examples of what online bullying is.
 Ask them what they could do if they experience this themselves or if they saw it happening to someone else
- · Come up with ideas to reduce cyberbullying
- Discuss why some people act differently online than they do in real life
