ACTIVATION

- Watch the clip from the documentary [‘First Footprints’](#)
- Explain that ‘footprints’ are a record of our experiences, culture and identity. Ask students to think about what it means to have a ‘digital footprint’ and its importance
- Explain that being aware of your digital footprint is not meant to make you feel shame but rather give you the opportunity to have a record of ourselves and our experiences
- Handout Digital Footprint Worksheet – 1 per student. Ask them to draw or write the important experiences that make them who they are

REFLECTION / EXTENSION

- Ask students to think about whether their digital footprint is a good record of who they are – discuss why or why not
- Encourage them to think about their digital footprint as an opportunity to express themselves and set a good example. Remind them to think before they act and post
