ACTIVATION

- Ask students to think of a role model – this could be someone close to them like a family member or it could be a public figure
- Explain how role models are people that live by their values and this is why they are respected, admired and trusted
- Handout My Values Worksheet – 1 per student
- Students will select three from a list of values. Encourage students to choose the ones that matter most to them – if it's not listed they can add their own!
- Encourage them to think about the way they behave online and align their values and actions

REFLECTION / EXTENSION

- Have a discussion about the importance of our online and in real life behaviour aligning with our values
- Discuss the different ways we can look out for each other online and how to reach out for help
- Ask students to list 5 people they could go to if they're having an issue online or in real life
